Dinner at our hotel. (B,D)

Friday 20th September 2019

Enjoy a day at leisure or join our optional excursion on the famous 'Round Robin' trip from Paignton to Totnes, travelling by both river boat and steam train with the Dartmouth Steam Railway & River Boat Company (at additional expense, details to be advised nearer departure date). Offering stunning views of the British coast, this is a real trip highlight. Return to our hotel for dinner. (B,D)

Saturday 21st September 2019
