

Thursday 16th January 2020

Today we depart Staffordshire and head to Manchester Airport for our flight to **Bridgetown** in **Barbados**. This scenic island is a great place to begin our relaxing holiday, as we transfer to the lovely Fred. Olsen ship *ms Braemar* our home for the next two weeks. We will stay in port overnight.

Friday 17th January 2020

With its balmy climate, glorious azure waters and incredible beaches, **Bridgetown** is a tropical city that epitomises paradise. The main street is often packed with welcoming locals and it's easy to see why Barbados is known as Little England given the Georgian houses, horse-racing track, Parliament Square and a statue of Nelson.

Saturday 18th January 2020

Today we dock in **Scarborough** on **Trinidad and Tobago**. Established in 1654 as the Dutch port of Lampsinburg, Scarborough is a lively, bustling little town dominated by the 18th century Fort King George that overlooks the town. Sail overnight to Bonaire.

Sunday 19th January 2020

Day at sea. Enjoy the ship's facilities as we cruise the Caribbean Sea, with plenty of opportunities to relax!

Monday 20th January 2020

Kralendijk, the lively, Dutch-controlled capital of **Bonaire**, is renowned for its stunning natural beauty and fantastic Caribbean climate. This colourful town is characterised by its many beaches dotted with quaint stucco houses in pastel shades of pink, green and blue. Surrounded by the protected Marine Park, the island's waters are home to large numbers of tropical fauna, rare seabirds and sea life, including turtles, tuna, blue marlin and sailfish.



Tuesday 21st January 2020

This morning we arrive in **Oranjestad**, the capital of the Dutch island of **Aruba**. The vividly coloured colonial buildings that mirror those in Amsterdam, clearly point to Oranjestad's rich Dutch heritage. The city is one of the Caribbean's true gems, combining European-style architecture with glorious white sand beaches, palm trees and flamingos.

Wednesday 22nd January 2020

Enjoy a day relaxing at sea. Bask in the sunshine and enjoy views across the sparkling waters from our comfortable ship.

Thursday 23rd January 2020

Arrive in **St George's**, the capital of **Grenada** early this morning. The town is a gateway to a volcanic island, with a jaw-dropping landscape of crater lakes, rainforests, coral reefs and white-sand beaches. The island affectionately known as the 'Spice Island' is famous for its cinnamon, mace, nutmeg and vanilla plantations. The aromas literally fill the air and make for a most remarkable experience when visiting the island.

Friday 24th January 2020

Today we arrive at **Castries**, the capital of the island nation of **St. Lucia**, known for its palm-lined, soft, white Vigie Beach. Like St. Lucia itself, the city combines heritage and culture with peace, relaxation and tranquillity, and Castries is a gateway to St. Lucia's wealth of national parks with vast forests, native plants and wildlife.

Saturday 25th January 2020

Enjoy a day exploring **Antigua**, an island often referred to as the crown jewel of the Caribbean. **St. John's** fascinating history is brought to life on the stunning English Harbour and celebrated Nelson's Dockyard. Also known as Britain's West Indies naval base, it has now been restored to its 18th century glory. The city of St John's is a sun worshipper's paradise and no visit would be complete without a spell on one of the island's 365 stunning beaches – one for each day of the year say the Antiguans.

Sunday 26th January 2020

This morning we arrive in **Basseterre** the elegant capital of **St Kitts and Nevis**. This beautiful town with some of the oldest colonial buildings in the Caribbean is bursting with history. Established by the French in the 17th century, and claimed by the British following the Napoleonic War, much of Basseterre's original Georgian architecture still stands and begs to be explored.

Monday 27th January 2020

Explore **Philipsburg** the capital of the Dutch half of **St. Maarten**, a Caribbean island amicably shared between Holland and France for centuries. This tiny island was divided between the Dutch and French in the 1600s, as a bastion against the Spanish and is a melting pot of rich cultures and old-world charm.

Tuesday 28th January 2020

Enjoy a full day to explore **Tortola** Island which is a famous pirate haunt of old. Road Town is typically old-world Caribbean and still retains a surreal charm. Capital of the British Virgin Islands, this picturesque town sits between rolling hills and white sandy bays and has a history to match its beguiling beauty.

Wednesday 29th January 2020

Enjoy a final day relaxing at sea and embrace the last of your Caribbean sunshine on the ms Braemar.

Thursday 30th January 2020

Enjoy some free time in La Romana in the Dominican Republic before joining our overnight flight back to the UK.

Friday 31st January 2020

Arrive into Manchester early morning with memories of a fantastic cruise along the balmy Caribbean seas.
