Itinerary and Ports of Call

Wednesday 16th October 2019

This morning fly from Manchester to **Budapest**. We transfer to the *ms Brabant*, our luxury river cruise ship, to settle in for the night.

Thursday 17th October 2019

Enjoy a cruise highlight today as we explore 'the city of two halves'. On opposite sides of the Danube, Budapest is made up of the elevated hill-tops of Buda and the flat pathways of Pest. Discover architectural gems including the neo-gothic Parliament Building, beautiful Fisherman's Bastion and Buda Castle.

Friday 18th October 2019

Sailing overnight, we arrive at the pretty Hungarian town of **Kalocsa** this morning. Explore the historic town and the famed 'paprika capital of the world' - the region's 'red gold'. Founded by St. Stephen, the First King of Hungary, Kalocsa is one of Hungary's oldest towns and one of the country's most important religious centres. The town is also renowned for producing vividly coloured folk embroideries and flowered porcelain. We set sail early afternoon, allowing you to relax and take in the sights and lovely views along the river.

Saturday 19th October 2019

This morning we arrive at historic **Belgrade**, the largest city and capital of Serbia, home of magnificent monuments and museums exhibiting Serbia's remarkable history, such as iconic Knez Mihailova Boulevard and the magnificent Kalemegdan Fortress, where views of beautiful natural scenery can be savoured.

Sunday 20th October 2019

Cruise the spectacular **Iron Gates Gorge** today, where the Danube separates the Balkan and Carpathian mountain ranges. Incredible scenery awaits as we pass through the Djerdap locks, the largest European dam outside Russia.

Monday 21st October 2019


After experiencing the scenic gorges, remote **Vidin** is our next stop. This fertile hinterland is renowned for its wines. The **Baba Vida Fortress**, one of Bulgaria's best preserved fortresses, is a highlight.

Tuesday 22nd October 2019

Our day begins in the charming city of **Ruse**. Often referred to as 'Little Vienna', this scenic area is brimming with extravagant architecture and elegant squares. The **Monument of Liberty** and the **Danube Bridge** are among many 'must-see' sites, and there are several interesting museums to stroll around. We dock here overnight.

Wednesday 23rd October 2019

Spend a relaxing morning sailing through the floodplains, by forests and islands of the Lower Danube. Alternatively, why not join our **optional excursion** to Bucharest, Romania's cultural capital? The fortress here was the first of many to be built to protect the Walachian State from the Turks, with plenty of history here to explore.



Daily live entertainment

Thursday 24th October 2019

After seeing the point where the Danube finally meets the Black Sea, we make a timely stop at **St Gheorghe**, a little fishing village not to be confused with the Transylvanian city of the same name – this is one of the most beautiful places on earth. We have the opportunity for another **optional excursion**, taking a small boat trip (at own expense) to the blissful **Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve**. Explore the marshlands in search of wonderful wildlife such as pelicans and hundreds of other bird species.

Friday 25th October 2019

Our journey on the River Danube ends at the western county line of Romania's picturesque **Constanta County, Hirsova**. We may have free time to explore this charming town (dependent on flight return times - to be advised), before we say goodbye to your luxury river cruise ship and fly back to England, with memories of a wonderful tour.
